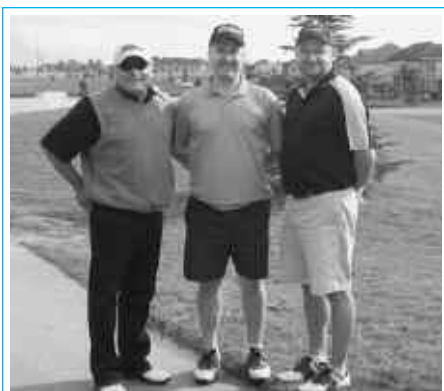

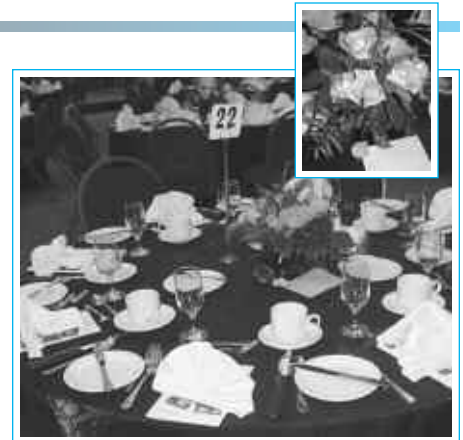
Gala Evening — Celebrating Catholic Education

Walter Podiluk Scholarship

Beginning in the 2009-2010 school year, the family of Walter Podiluk, former teacher, administrator and director of education in Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools has established an annual scholarship. This scholarship, initially set at \$300.00, will be awarded to a Grade 12 student graduating from the Ukrainian Bilingual Program and enrolling in the Sheptytsky Institute at the University of Saskatchewan. If there are no students registering through Sheptytsky, a student from the Ukrainian Bilingual Program registering through St. Thomas More at the University of Saskatchewan

would be eligible to receive the Walter Podiluk Memorial Scholarship.

Currently based at Bethlehem Catholic High School the Ukrainian Bilingual Program provides students the opportunity to enhance their knowledge and mastery of the Ukrainian language by taking several of their high school classes with Ukrainian as the language of instruction.

Walter was very proud of his Ukrainian background and was instrumental in the establishment of the original Ukrainian Program at E.D. Feehan Catholic High School. Bishop Filevich Elementary School is

a full Ukrainian Immersion school for elementary students. Students who wish to continue their program in Ukrainian enrol at Bethlehem Catholic High School.

The Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools Foundation welcomes the addition of the Walter Podiluk Memorial Scholarship and thanks the Podiluk family for its generosity. If former students and staff of the school division would like to contribute to this specific scholarship fund in honour of Mr. Podiluk they should contact the Foundation office. Tax receipts are issued for all donations over \$10.00. ■

Legacy of Leadership Program

Each year the Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools Foundation receives contributions in the name of individuals who have passed away who were current or former employees of the Greater Saskatoon Catholic School Division, or students whose death occurs while attending Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools. If staffs were to participate in dress down days once a month and

individual staff members paid \$5/month, a tax receipt could be issued for \$50 (if collected onetime). The Foundation requires the name and address of any individual requiring a receipt.
