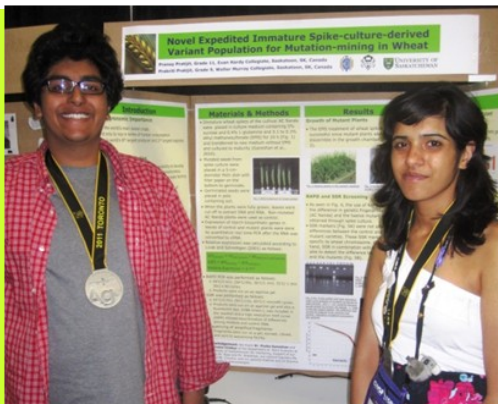


## CWSF

## What is the Saskatoon Regional Science Fair?

The Saskatoon Regional Science Fair provides an opportunity for our burgeoning young scientists to display their scientific achievements to Saskatoon and the surrounding community. Each year, approximately 100 grade 7 to grade 12 students from the city of Saskatoon and the Prairie Spirit School Division come together to exhibit their experiments, compete for prizes, and vie for a chance to represent the Saskatoon Region at the Canada Wide Science Fair, which is being held in Charlottetown, PEI this year.



## Who Can Participate in the Science Fair?

If you enjoy learning about science and the process it takes to discover something new, then you are an excellent candidate for the fair! Often, many of our participants are in grades 7-12 and are from schools in Saskatoon and the surrounding Prairie Spirit School Division. Many students have the opportunity to complete a project through their school curriculum and are wanting to show it to members of the community. However, a project does not need to be completed as part of a school assignment. Anyone who is interested in a particular subject and loves to explore the many aspects of a project through experiment, study or innovation can enter the Saskatoon Regional Science Fair.

At the Saskatoon Regional Science Fair, projects can be divided into certain subject areas. The current science divisions are:

- Biotechnology
- Earth and Environmental Sciences

- Engineering and Computer Sciences
- Health Sciences
- Life Science
- Physical and Math Sciences

Some other special divisions may be used where necessary, as science moves on to new challenges.

During this event, students have the chance to participate in a variety of science-related activities and are able to share their project with judges and members of the community. Amongst all this, they also have the opportunity to compete for prizes and a spot to attend the Canada Wide Science Fair.
