SECONDARY LEVEL			
<p>Check all equipment regularly for defects.</p> <p>Make arm guards and finger tabs available to students.</p> <p>Match bow length and weight to the height and strength of the participant.</p> <p>Use appropriate targets.</p>	<p>Use an area free of obstructions and hazards.</p> <p>For indoor shooting, use a properly installed safety net and netting beyond targets.</p> <p>Control access/exit to the facility.</p> <p>For outdoor activity, mark and control the shooting area.</p>	<p>Establish a "firing" line appropriate to the skill level of the students.</p> <p>Keep everyone behind the firing line.</p> <p>Establish a "start" and "stop" shooting and retrieving procedure.</p> <p>Instruct students in safety procedures, shooting techniques, care and use of equipment and how to properly remove an arrow from a target butt.</p> <p>Never point a loaded bow at anyone.</p> <p>Load bows on the shooting line only.</p> <p>Position all students not involved in shooting well behind the firing line and away from the archers on the line.</p> <p>Teach skills in proper progression.</p>	<p>Provide constant visual supervision.</p>
