Community schools celebrate spring with Intertribal Powwow

Six community schools in Saskatoon are hosting the Second Annual Saskatoon West Intertribal Traditional Powwow on **Thursday, May 18 at E.D. Feehan Catholic High School (411 Avenue M North)**.

This powwow is a gathering to bring together school and neighbourhood communities to celebrate spring's arrival. The day begins with a community pancake breakfast at 8:00 a.m., followed by a Pipe Ceremony at 9:00 a.m. Grand Entry is set for 10 a.m. and Grand Exit is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. A number of local residents will be exhibiting and selling their arts and crafts at the powwow.

This event is organized by representatives from E.D. Feehan Catholic High School, St. Maria Goretti Community School, St. Michael Community School, Mount Royal Collegiate, Pleasant Hill Community School, Princess Alexandra Community School, and Westmount Community School. Last year's powwow, which featured nearly 200 dancers and 12 drum groups, was attended by more than 2,000 people.
